- ▶ Mar. 7 or 9 — Bring artwork to the Gallery between 11 am-2 pm.
NO LATE WORK ACCEPTED!! Work MAY be brought earlier.
- ▶ Mar. 16 – Opening reception 5-7 pm

- ▶ Apr. 6 – Pick up artwork 1:30-2 pm
- ◆ Artists MUST contribute to the reception, either by bringing appetizers or donating funds to purchase wine or appetizers.
- ◆ \$5 entry fee per item. Limit 4 entries per artist. If any entry is over the equivalent of 30” wide, it will count as 2 entries (\$10).
- ◆ All entered artwork MUST BE FOR SALE.

- ◆ 30% commission will be charged on sales. Nonmembers—35% commission
