We strive to educate both the public as well as beginning artists in many aspects of the art world. One of our objectives is to instruct artists in how to prepare artwork for entering art shows. When artwork is submitted for a SPACe show, it will be examined to make sure the art is properly presented for display in a gallery. The artist will be apprised of any unsatisfactory aspects of the presentation (framing etc) and asked to make corrections. SPACe endeavors to provide a limited amount of materials for framing in the upstairs workspace.

We require wires securely attached to the back of hanging artwork. Other types of hangers do not work with our hanging system. Artwork may fall off the wall or is too difficult to hang without a wire. Please don't hesitate to ask one of our staff to advise you.

PLEASE PRINT -- attach these identification tags to the FRONT or SIDE of your artwork so they can be seen from the front. Be careful not to damage your frames!

CHECKLIST for artwork acceptability entered in SPACe shows

- ✓ Artwork securely framed.
- ✓ No nicks, scratches on frame
- ✓ Mats clean
- ✓ Glass clean
- ✓ Wire on the back
- ✓ Canvas properly stretched
- ✓ SPACe ID tag on side or front
- ✓ Artist name and title on the back of artwork
- ✓ 3D work easily moved—all parts attached as one piece
- ✓ Secure stand provided for jewelry.
- ✓ Adequate display stand or hanging hardware for fiber art

CONSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

The following terms and conditions are agreed to by the undersigned artist or representative:

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE FOR SALE. Entry fees are non-refundable. All entries are properly presented for display. Wall art is fitted with a secure wire on the back, **no sawtooth hangers**. 3D art can be easily moved as one piece. Secure stands are provided by the artist for jewelry.

A commission will be deducted from the listed price when any of the listed artwork is sold as a result of its presence in this show. The commission rate is 30% for SPACe members and 35% for nonmembers. Payment will be made after the end of the month during which the sale was concluded to the address provided.

The Gallery, SPACe, its officers, volunteers, and employees do not assume responsibility for any works that are lost, stolen, or damaged while in the Gallery's possession. Insurance is the responsibility of the artist. Every effort will be maintained to prevent any such loss.

The consigned works may be claimed and removed between 1:30-2:30 pm on Sept. 24. Arrangements must be made in advance with the Gallery staff, for later pick-up. Any items left over 60 days become the property of SPACe to be used for fundraising.

Artists are invited to enter up to 4 pieces of original artwork in any media and style. Show us how you express changes. "The only constant in life is change" Artwork must be for sale. NO GICLEE PRINTS, except photography. Artwork that has been shown at SPACe in the past 12 months, including the gift shop, cannot be included in the show.

▶ **Aug. 25,26,27**--Bring artwork to SPACe 10 am-2 pm.

NO LATE WORK ACCEPTED!! Work MAY be brought earlier.

▶ **Sept. 3** – Opening reception 5-7 pm

▶ **Sept. 24** – Pick up artwork 1:30-2:30 pm

♦ **\$5 entry fee per item.** Limit 4 entries per artist. Sold artwork may be replaced for no additional fee. If any entry is over the equivalent of 30" wide, it will count as 2 entries (\$10).

♦ All entered artwork MUST BE FOR SALE.

♦ 30% commission charged on sales/ 35% Nonmembers
Payment for sold artwork is made in the month after the show ends.

♦ Artwork may be photographed for used in publicity, including Facebook, the SPACe website and YouTube.

Artists entering works that are framed under glass are encouraged to send digital images for publicity purposes. See below for email address.

Hanging art must be properly presented and have a secure **WIRE ON THE BACK**, no sawtooth hangers. See CHECKLIST for complete requirements.

SPACe members who live too far away to hand deliver their artwork may ship artwork entered in this show, as long as it arrives by Aug. 27 and can be picked up on Sept. 24. Arrangements can be made to pick up work at a later date. Shipped artwork must be sent via US Postal Service to the SPACe P.O. Box 803. DO NOT SHIP GLASS. Framed artwork must be protected with plexiglas or similar glazing. Include a copy of this entry form and the required entry fees, as well as membership dues if applicable.
