Education is the thing that sets us apart as a non-profit. This year we have experienced challenges in attracting participation in both the Youth Art Workshop and Adult Workshops. We realize that the market has changed over the last few years and we will need to change with it to continue our mission.

The Western Rendezvous Show



Western Rendezvous is a juried and judged show with cash awards. This show featured 45 pieces from 21 local and regional artists and was an outstanding success with awards presented at the opening reception. Our judge, Tom Lockhart, awarded a First Place to Mary Cardin for her watercolor, "September in the San Juans", a Second Place to Albert Anderson Clymer for his painting, "Wounded Knee Study #42", and a Third Place award to Lynette Green for her painting, "Looking Downstream". Two merit ribbons were also awarded. We appreciate a generous donation from the La Veta Creative District that helped to offset costs associated with this show.



This show featured a total of 180 entries which were juried down to 45 accepted for the show. Our judge, Steven Bigley, selected a First Place award for James Van Hoy of Colorado Springs, CO, for his piece, "All Twisted Up", a Second Place award for Michael Chioran of New York, NY, for "Avenue 1", and a Third Place award for Nathan McCreery of Clovis, NM, for "Corn Lily Detail,". Two merit awards were also presented. Even though we received outstanding works through the online entity, Café, some of our regional photographers chose not to enter because of having to deal with the requirements for entering. For that reason we will not go through Café again next year.
