

Albert Anderson Clymer, a Denison, TX reared realist, whose goals were once set on an architectural career, has painted a path to fame since trading his T-square and drafting board for an artist's brush and canvas. While attending Texas A & M University he became aware of design through architecture courses and began experimenting with painting techniques, painting on Masonite fiberboard-to create his own style: Brushing a thin wash of color to areas of a painting to achieve unusual effects dispersing a coagulation of the color wash with the board lying flat or slightly tilted. Within seconds, the coagulation begins and can be stopped if held in sunlight. In 1967 Al abandoned architecture to become a professional artist. The transition was an easy one because it fit in with his life goals. "I wanted to be self-employed-to have absolute freedom".
