Greetings, Members of SPACe and Patrons of the Arts:

As we enter this year's fourth quarter, the Spanish Peaks Arts Council is preparing for a repeat of our successful 2024 Fall fundraising appeal with a 2025 Second Fall appeal. As with the previous fourth quarter drive, we will emphasize donations that are tax deductible and that funds an organization supporting the arts in our community. One added benefit of last year's appeal was the addition of a number of new members and renewals. We anticipate a good response from this important fundraising drive. Our goal is to raise \$15,000 for day-to-day operations and building maintenance.

The 2025 Art in the Park arts and crafts fair was a very profitable fundraiser with SPACe realizing much needed income for operating expenses! Dedication, planning and hard work by treasurer, Susan Smith and family, Rafe Schneider, Cherine and Mark Kuster, along with generous donations from San Isabel Electric and La Veta Creative District made this event successful! You can be a part of this paid event by being the coordinator for next year! Commission paid is 30% after expenses are satisfied.

Another fundraiser is one that was begun in 2015 when the Cottonwood Bench project was in progress. For that endeavor, personalized and memorial bricks were sold to raise funds. For one reason or another the project languished and was never finished. Our Treasurer Susan, being a thorough bookkeeper, restarted the project and we have been able to complete and place our order for 79 bricks with a tidy amount raised for SPACe.

Our Youth Art Workshop was a really good experience for the small number of young artists who signed up. Taught by local artist, Cathryn "Kitty" Gladyshev, the five day event in July gave each student an opportunity to use a variety of mediums in a multitude of creative visual art activities.

Two big shows at SPACe, the Western and Photography Show, which are the highlights of our Summer art show season, were outstanding with great work, but somewhat tepid sales – a sign of the times.

SPACe plans our year of shows and other events during our January hiatus. Not only will we need a coordinator for Art in the Park, but a coordinator to plan and promote adult art workshops in 2026. This is also a position that pays the coordinator with a commission on the income from student tuitions. Please give some thought to coordinating this rewarding activity.

It is no accident that I emphasize fundraising in these notes. Spanish Peaks Arts Council is, in every sense of the word, a nonprofit. We spend the money we collect from fees, dues and commissions to produce shows that benefit our members and the community. We need income from fundraising to pay our operating expenses. We will always support you, our member artists, by keeping our costs low and still continue our mission to provide educational opportunities and a venue for displaying and selling your work.
